Prayer in this petition is to quash kalendra under Section 182
IPC recorded vide rapat No.23 dated 13.09.2019 (Annexure P.1)
registered at Police Station Women Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Mr. R.S. Khaira, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent- State. Dr. Rau P.S. Girwar, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2 and filed her Memo of Appearance.

“It is conceded by counsel for both the parties that all the disputes between the parties have since been settled. Even petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act has already been decided vide order dated 11.04.2023 of Family Court, Bathinda, and therefore this petition has become infructuous.

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petitioner will file a separate petition to quash that Kalendra.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that he has no objection so as to withdraw this petition, if there is statement on behalf of respondent that he will not raise any objection for quashing the Kalendra.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that Kalendra under Section 182 IPC being a State matter, he will have no objection to quash the said Kalendra.

In view of the aforesaid statements made by learned counsel for both the parties, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn, having become infructuous, on account of compromise between the parties.”

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has no objection to quash the kalendra in question under Section 182 IPC (Annexure P.1) in view of the order earlier passed by this Court vide Annexure P.3.

In view of the order earlier passed by this Court vide Annexure P.3, the present petition is allowed and the kalendra filed under Section 182 IPC recorded vide rapat No.23 dated 13.09.2019 (Annexure P.1) registered at Police Station Women Bathinda, District Bathinda, is hereby quashed, alongwith all consequent proceedings.
