This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the order dated 19.02.2016 (Annexure P-5) passed by the Divisional Canal Officer and order dated 09.08.2016 (Annexure P-7) passed by the Superintending Canal Officer, whereby, the Canal Authorities have ordered for the restoration of water course B-D from the land of the petitioner.

On 16.01.2023, this Court had passed the following order:-
