Although, instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to re-engage the petitioner as a Canal Patwari, in view of the outsourcing policy of the Government, but counsel for the petitioner submits that during the pendency of the petition, petitioner has been deployed in February, 2022, as Canal Patwari by Haryana Kaushal Rozgar Nigam.

In view of the above, nothing survives in the petition, which is rendered infructuous and is dismissed as such.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to approach the respondents by submitting a representation, in case his services are dis-engaged.
