VIVEK PURI, J.(ORAL)

1. The petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 4 for protection of his life and liberty and that of his family members as he is apprehending danger at the hands of respondents No. 5 and 6.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that an FIR No. 157 dated 20.04.2022 under Sections 366A, 376D, 450, 506 IPC and Section 6 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, District Nuh has been registered at Police Station Punhana against respondent Nos. 5 and 6 and Parvej as they had sexually exploited his daughter. The petitioner is apprehending danger to his life and liberty at the instance of respondent Nos. 5 and 6 and he has submitted a representation, Annexure P-4 to respondent No.3 .

3. Status report by way of affidavit of Ashok Kumar, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Punhana on behalf of respondents no. 1 to 4 has been placed on record.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Manoj Kumar, submits that on conclusion of investigation, the challan has been presented against Parvej. However, respondents No. 5 and 6 have been found to be innocent. Furthermore, inquiry in the matter was conducted and there is no threat perception to the petitioner.
5. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition.
6. Dismissed as withdrawn.
