This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.475 dated 15.05.2018 under Section 135 of Electricity Act, 2003, registered at Police Station Anti Power Theft, Jalandhar (Annexure P-5) and also subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Notice of motion in this case was issued on 18.08.2022 by recording the following contention of the petitioner:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the notice (Annexure P-4), the petitioner has deposited an amount of Rs.92,661/-, however, the compounding fee of Rs.27,000/- has not been accepted by respondent No.2. He relies upon the provisions of Section 152 of the Electricity Act, 2003 which relates to compounding of offences.

The petitioner is directed to bring a draft of Rs.27,000/- on the next date of hearing.
