Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the present petition, the prayer of the petitioner is for the grant of benefit of further promotion to the post of Joint Director, Horticulture, which is not being granted to the petitioner by the respondents though, the petitioner has already been granted the benefit of ACP while working on the post of Deputy Director, Horticulture hence, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to file an appropriate representation with the respondents bringing to their notice the fact that once the benefit of ACP has been granted to the petitioner in the cadre of Deputy Director (Horticulture), same period, which has been taken into account as relevant period for the grant of benefit of ACP, the said period should also be taken into account as experience for the purpose of grant of benefit of promotion to the post of Joint Director

(Horticulture).

Learned State counsel submits that in case any representation raising the said claim is filed by the petitioner, the same will be decided by the respondents in accordance with law within period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by the learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.
