1. Prayer in this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C is for directions to official respondent Nos.2 and 3 to conduct a free and fair investigation by taking appropriate action against respondent Nos.4 and 5 for committing the offence of outraging the modesty, snatching/theft as the local police is hand in glove with the accused-respondents.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that apprehending threat to her life and property at the hands of private respondent Nos.4 to 15, the petitioner has approached respondent No.2 as well as respondent No.3 and those application(s) are pending consideration. It is further submitted, that the petitioner would be satisfied at this stage in case his application(s) is disposed of in a time bound manner.
3. At the asking of the Court, Mr. Sanish Girdhar, AAG, Punjab, puts in appearance on behalf of the official respondents. A complete copy of the paper-book supplied to him in Court.

- 4. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
- 5. In view of the above, without expressing any opinion or commenting on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) (respondent No.2), to look into the grievance of the petitioner and if any action is required to be taken thereon, such action be taken by the concerned officials/respondent, in accordance with law, within a period of 4 weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
- 6. The petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
