It has been submitted by Mr. Rajesh Garg, learned Senior counsel appearing on behalf of respondent Nos.1 & 2 that identical writ petitions have been decided by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court by which the petitions were disposed of on the ground that there is a provision for arbitration and the petitioners were relegated to the arbitrator. The aforesaid judgment has been passed in **CWP-20885-2016** titled s “**M/s M.B. Rice &**

General Mills Vs. Union of India and others” decided on 06.08.2018 and the same was assailed before the Division Bench of this Court in LPA-2043-2016 and the aforesaid LPA has also been dismissed on 24.05.2022.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the aforesaid position is not disputed and the present petition may also be disposed of by relegating the petitioner to the arbitration proceedings.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of in terms of judgment dated 06.08.2018 passed in the aforesaid writ petition.
