1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash impugned retirement notice letter no.9686 dated 21.06.2023 (Annexure P-7).

2. On 20.07.2023, this Court was pleased to pass the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that although the ACRs for the year 01.04.2022 to 31.03.2023 records that the integrity of the petitioner is doubtful, but an appeal against the same has been filed on 06.06.2023 (Annexure P-6) before the Additional Director General of Police, South Range, Rewari. It is further submitted that the petitioner would stand prematurely retired after three months from the date of notice dated 21.06.2023 i.e. on 21.09.2023.

Notice of motion 05.09.2023.

Notice re: stay as well.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Rajni Gupta, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, appears & accepts notice on behalf of the respondents

No.1 to 4-State.

Liberty is granted to the petitioner to serve respondent No.5 through dasti process as well.

The Additional Director General of Police, South Range, Rewari is directed to consider the appeal filed by the petitioner on 06.06.2023 (Annexure P-6) as expeditiously as possible, preferably, prior to the next date of hearing i.e. 05.09.2023.

3. Learned State counsel has filed a short reply dated 28.08.2023 which is taken on record. A copy of the same has been given to learned counsel for the petitioner. Learned State counsel has submitted that the present petition has been rendered infructuous inasmuch the relief which has been prayed by the petitioner, has been granted to the petitioner and the retirement notice dated 21.06.2023 has been withdrawn.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the same, the present petition be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
