MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.74 dated 03.06.2022 under Sections 326, 324, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Dayalpura, District Bathinda.

2. On the last date of hearing/on 20.07.2023, while noticing the following submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner and asked him to join investigation:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been attributed a simple injury and that too on the palm on the right hand of the complainant, which is non-vital part of the body. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner is ready and willing to join investigation and will cooperate with the investigating agency.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 20.07.2023, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

4. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Bogha

Singh, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He further submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

5. In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 20.07.2023, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
