1. The petitioner is seeking cancellation of regular bail granted to respondent No.2 in CRM-M-14192-2020, titled as 'Ramesh Chand Vs. State of Haryana' in terms of the order dated 19.06.2020 in the case bearing FIR No.35 dated 02.03.2020 under Sections 376-D/506/120-B IPC registered at Police Station Sadhaura, District Yamuna Nagar.

2. On 13.07.2023, the following order was passed:-

“1. On instructions from ASI Jitender Singh, learned State counsel submits that the statement of the prosecutrix has been recorded and respondent No.2 has been acquitted by the trial Court in terms of judgment dated 14.02.2023.

2. None has appeared on behalf of respondent No.2 despite pass over.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks time to verify this aspect of the matter.

4. On his request, adjourned to 27.07.2023.”

3. On 27.07.2023, none had appeared on behalf of the petitioner. Even today, none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner despite pass over.

4. In view of the submission made by learned State counsel in terms of the order dated 13.07.2023, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

5. As none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner, she shall be at liberty to move an application for revival of the petition within a period of three months, if the aforesaid assertion of learned State counsel is found to be factually incorrect.
