Learned counsel for the petitioner very fairly submits that keeping in view the judgment of the Division Bench of this Court in **LPA No.160-2021 titled as Tinku vs. State of Haryana and others decided on 22.03.2022** claim of the petitioner is covered against her hence, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

2. Ordered accordingly

3. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in case the petitioner is not entitled for the grant of benefit of compassionate appointment, the petitioner be allowed to approach the respondents for the grant of benefit of exgratia financial assistance for which, the family is entitled for, and the respondents be directed to decide the same in a time bound manner.

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Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any

application is received from the petitioner for the grant of exgratia financial assistance, the same will be considered in accordance with law and an appropriate order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of any such claim and in case the petitioner is found entitled for the relief, the same will be extended to her within a period of further four weeks.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by the learned counsel for the respondents, present petitions may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondents for the grant of benefit of exgratia financial assistance.
5. Ordered accordingly.
