1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking grant of post-arrest bail in:-

FIR No.	Dated	Police Station	Sections
29	20.07.2022	Thulliwal, District Barnala	22 and 27 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985

2. Petitioner has been found to be in possession of 760 loose tablets, which on examination were found to contain 316 grams of Tramadol.

3. State counsel has filed custody certificate dated 20.07.2023, which is taken on record. Its perusal shows that the petitioner is involved in two other criminal cases, but none for the cases except the present one is for an offence under the NDPS Act.

4. At this stage, counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has earned an acquittal in both the criminal cases.

5. When confronted with the bar under Section 37 of the NDPS Act, counsel for the petitioner has sought and is granted permission to withdraw the present petition.

6. Dismissed as withdrawn.
