1. This is a petition seeking quashing of order dated 6.6.2023 whereby the bail order of the petitioners was cancelled and the non-bailable warrants were issued.

2. Petitioners are accused in FIR No. 425, dated 13.11.2019 under Sections 379-B, IPC, 1860 registered at P.S. Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar, Mohali. Petitioners were granted bail by the Sessions Court on 14.7.2020. They failed to appear in Court on 6.6.2023 and the impugned order was passed.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after grant of bail, the petitioners were regularly appearing but on 6.6.2023 could not appear as date was wrongly noted as 7.6.2023 instead of 6.6.2023. He on instructions submits that petitioners would surrender before the Court concerned within fifteen days from today and shall apply for regular bail, the same be directed to be decided expeditiously.

4. Learned State Counsel appearing on advance notice submits that presence of the petitioner during trial should be ensured so that there is no delay in trial.
5. The petition is disposed of. In eventuality of petitioners surrendering before the trial Court within fifteen days from today and applying for regular bail, their application shall be decided by the Court concerned on the same day.
6. Needless to say that the Court concerned shall be at liberty to impose conditions as deem necessary for ensuring the presence of the petitioners during trial.
7. Since the main case has been disposed of the pending application(s), if any is rendered infructuous.
