1. This is an application filed under Section 151 of CPC for withdrawal of the main writ petition.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant/petitioner has submitted that the main case is now listed for 28.09.2023 and he does not wish to pursue the same and thus, prays for allowing of the application and for the preponement of the main case from 28.09.2023 to today itself.
3. On the other hand, learned counsel for the non-applicants/respondents have submitted that they have no objection in

case the present application is allowed and the date of hearing in the main case is preponed from 28.09.2023 to today itself for final disposal.

4. For the reasons stated in the application which is duly supported by an affidavit and also in view of no objection from the opposite side, the present application is allowed and the date of hearing in the main case is preponed from 28.09.2023 to today and the same is taken on Board today itself for final disposal.

Main case

1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction especially in the nature of certiorari for quashing of impugned order dated 14.07.2022 (Annexure P-4), whereby, the petitioner was directed to vacate the house in question.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he does not wish to pursue the present writ petition and thus, seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present writ petition.

3. In view of the above, the present Civil Writ Petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

4. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
