This is a civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside / quashing of the impugned order dated 15.07.2019 (Annexure P-5) whereby respondent no.5 has been appointed as Administrator for the grant of the village.

Learned State counsel, on written instructions from BDPO, has submitted that in the present case there is no Administrator required and development work is going on properly and thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
