The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in respect of a case registered against him vide FIR No.39 dated 29.01.2020 at Police Station City Barnala, District Barnala, under Section 22 of the NDPS Act.

Learned State counsel, at the very outset, has informed that all the PWs already stand examined.

In view of the aforestated position i.e. trial being at its fag end, this Court does not deem appropriate to grant bail to the petitioner at this stage. The petition, as such, is dismissed.

However, it shall be open to the petitioner to apply for grant of bail in case there is an inordinate delay in conclusion of trial.

The trial Court to take all necessary steps for expeditious conclusion of trial.
