Application is allowed. Documents-copies of vaccination register, ration card, aadhar card, compromise, matriculation certificate, PAN card, migration certificate, petition under section 10 of the Guardians and Wards Act, 1890, application under Order 1 Rule 10 CPC, reply to application and receipt of property tax, are taken on record as Annexures R-4/1 to R-4/11 respectively.

CWP No.23057 of 2016

This petition has been filed seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to release final payment of GPF of late Tarsem Lal to the petitioner being his nominee, alongwith interest @ 18% per annum.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner as well as respondent no.4, another claimant of the GPF, are *ad idem* that a settlement has been arrived at between them regarding claim to the GPF amount of late Tarsem Lal. On the basis of settlement, they will now approach the respondents for release of the amount and other benefits as may be due to them.

3. In view thereof, the petitioner does not intend to press the petition.

4. Dismissed as not pressed with liberty to approach the respondents for release of the benefits claimed in the petition.
