The petitioner is alleging violation of the order dated 29.10.2020, passed by this Court in CWP-17951-2020, vide which, the following directions were issued:

“Without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority amongst the respondents to take a decision on the aforesaid representation of the petitioner by passing a detailed speaking order, answering each and every contention raised in the said representation. within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

While deciding the said representation, the report, Annexure P8, (seen to be signed by three persons, including the Assistant Engineer, Enforcement), shall be taken into consideration.

If a completely detailed speaking order has already been passed by the competent authority, then only a short order would now need to be passed, annexing therewith the

detailed order already passed (if any).

It is again made clear that this court has not made any comment whatsoever on the contentions raised in the present petition.”

As per affidavit, filed by the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Gurugram, a speaking order has already been passed on 31.03.2021, vide Annexure R-3.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous.

Rule stands discharged.

The petitioner is granted liberty to avail the alternative remedy, in accordance with law, if so advised.
