1 On 19.07.2023, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that the proceedings under Chapter VI of the Cr.P.C. which culminated in the impugned order are in the teeth of bare provisions of law as there is a report specific to the extent that the petitioner was not living on the said address.

Notice of motion returnable for 12.09.2023.

The petitioner shall appear before the Railway Magistrate on 24.07.2023. On his appearance he shall be permitted to furnish bail bonds.”

2 Thereafter on 12.09.2023 the following order was passed :-

“On 19th of July, 2023 while issuing notice of motion the following order was passed :

“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that the proceedings under Chapter VI of the Cr.P.C. which culminated in the impugned order are in the teeth of bare provisions of law as there is a report specific to the extent that the petitioner was not living on the said address.

Notice of motion returnable for 12.09.2023.

The petitioner shall appear before the Railway Magistrate on 24.07.2023. On his appearance he shall be permitted to furnish bail bonds.”

Today Counsel for the petitioner has produced copy of the order dated 24th of July, 2023 passed by the SRM/JMIC Ambala. As per which, the petitioner surrendered before the Trial Court and now stands admitted to bail.

State Counsel prays for time to file reply.

Adjourned to 07.11.2023.”

3 Reply by way of an affidavit of Rajesh Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police GRP, Railway (H) Ambala Cantt., District Ambala on behalf of respondent has been filed. The same is taken on record.

4 Copy of the order dated 24.07.2023 has been produced. The petitioner is stated to have appeared before the trial Court and now stands admitted to bail.

5 In view of above, the interim order dated 19.07.2023 passed by this Court is made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall continue to appear without any fault.

6 Petition stands disposed off.
