By this common order, the bunch of eight writ petitions, details of which have been given in the heading, are being decided as all the writ petitions involve same question of law and similar facts.

Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that the issue as has been raised in the present petition, is similar to that raised in **CWP-12582-2019** titled as **‘Vishal Kumar Vs. State of Haryana and others’** which has been disposed of vide order dated 08.08.2023, hence present petition be also disposed of in view of Vishal Kumar’s case (supra).

Learned State counsel submits that though question of law raised in the petition is similar to that one raised in Vishal Kumar’s case (supra) but the said case was decided on the basis of another judgment passed in **‘Zile Singh Vs. State of Haryana and others’ CWP No.27328 of 2018**, which decision in **Zile Singh’s** case (supra) is already under review, which fact may kindly be noticed.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, as the question of law raised in present petition is similar to the one raised in **CWP-12582-2019 (Vishal Kumar Vs. State of Haryana and others)**, the present petitions are also disposed of in the same terms. It may be noticed that mere pendency of a review does not mean that the order passed in **Zile Singh’s** case (Supra) will not be applicable upon the others.
