Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.60 dated 16.03.2022 under Section 306 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Samana, District Patiala.

It is the case of the petitioner that the basic ingredients to attract mischief of an offence under Sections 306/107 IPC are not made out in the case in hand as only vague allegations have been levelled against her in the suicide note left behind by the deceased that all the persons mentioned therein including the petitioner were responsible for his death.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 24.08.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

Learned State counsel, on instructions does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined the investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He on further instructions submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for her custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, the petition is allowed and the interim order dated 24.08.2022 is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
