By means of this writ petition under Article 226 Constitution of India petitioners have prayed for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus for issuance of directions to respondents to allow them to join the post of office attendants.

On 18.08.2022, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners has participated in the process of selection of Office Attendants and were duly selected as per their merits. Even, the appointment letters were issued to the petitioners. However, they are not permitted to join their duties, for no reason whatsoever.

Notice of motion for 09.11.2022.”

Today, learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners have been allowed to join pursuant to their letter of appointments and grievance stands redressed. He states that he has instructions to withdraw this petition.
