The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* for challenging the action of the passport authorities for the closure of the file of the petitioner by which he had filed an application for grant of passport with a further direction to the Passport Authorities to issue the passport to the petitioner.
