Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No. 156 dated 19.05.2023, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 379-A read with Section 34 and 177 of IPC, 1860, at Police Station Sector-14, Gurugram, Haryana.

2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegations against the petitioner is that she was not in company with the co-accused who is stated to have stolen/snatched gold chain of co-passenger which was not recovered from the petitioner or the co-accused, but was found from the road. Petitioner has already suffered incarceration for more than 03 months and has no criminal antecedents. Apart therefrom the petitioner is in family way in around 30 week of her pregnancy as is evident from ultrasound report placed on record as Annexure P-3.

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3. Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has already suffered incarceration and considering her medical condition, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on her furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

4. Needless to say nothing recorded herein shall be construed to be an expression of an opinion on the merits of the case.
