Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.38 dated 24.3.2022 registered under Sections 324, 323, 427, 452, 148, 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Cantt. Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

Counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and even otherwise, no grievous injury is attributed to him which is stated to be caused by co-accused Honey alias Lallu who stands arrested and that the petitioner joined the investigation with the police by virtue of order of interim bail dated 25.8.2022 passed by this Court. State counsel on instructions from ASI Tarlok Singh has admitted that the petitioner joined the investigation with the police in compliance of previous order of interim bail and further submits that no grievous injury is attributed to the present petitioner and the

grievous injury is attracted only to one Honey @ Lallu who is arrested by

the police and further submits that the petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation as recovery of the weapon used in the commission of the crime stands effected.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 25.8.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
