1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.74 dated 15.06.2023, registered under Sections 307, 458, 324, 148, 149, 427 of IPC, at Police Station Nihal Singh Wala, District Moga.

2. In compliance of order dated 20.07.2023, status report by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police Sub-Division, Nihal Singh Wala, District Moga has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State in Court today and the same is taken on record.
