LISA GILL, J.

1. This appeal has been filed by the appellant-husband, challenging judgment and decree dated 02.08.2021, passed by learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Ludhiana, whereby his petition under Section 13(1) (ia) and (ib) of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (hereinafter referred to as the Act), has been dismissed.

2. Matter has been amicably resolved between the parties. It is agreed that a sum of ₹11,00,000/- (eleven lacs) shall be handed over by appellant to respondent as full and final settlement of all her claims including permanent alimony, maintenance etc. It is submitted that a petition under Section 13-B of the Act has been filed. Statements of parties at first motion stand recorded and matter is now listed for recording of statements of parties at second motion on 21.08.2023.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent affirms and verifies the same. It is submitted that both the parties shall adhere to the terms and conditions of the settlement.

4. In view of the settlement, learned counsel for the appellant seeks to withdraw this appeal with liberty to appellant to file appropriate application for revival in case, terms and conditions of the settlement are not adhered to by respondent.

5. Appeal is accordingly dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforementioned.
