The petitioner is alleging violation of the order dated 08.07.2019 passed by this Court in CWP-19726-2015, vide which, a direction was issued to the respondents to consider and release the retiral benefits found due to the petitioner in terms of an earlier order passed by this Court in Manjit Kaur's case.

As per Manjit Kaur's case, it was directed that the necessary benefit will be given along with 12% interest per annum.

Learned State counsel submits that by passing a speaking order, the claim of the petitioner has been settled and in para 11 of the affidavit of Principal, Govt. Senior Secondary School, Dahar, District Panipat, dated 16.06.2021, which is on record, it is specifically stated that Gratuity, Commutation of Pension etc. have been paid to the petitioner with the

maximum financial benefits (with interest), in compliance with the order passed by this Court. It is also explained in the affidavit that there was some delay on account of non-submission of 'Life Certificate', which was required to be submitted by the petitioner in the Treasury Office.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the interest has not been paid to the petitioner, however, a perusal of the aforesaid affidavit would show that the amount was paid way back in 2015 and 2016.

In view of the same, no further action is called for in the present petition and the same is disposed of.

Rule stands discharged.

The petitioner is granted liberty to avail his alternative remedy in accordance with law, if so advised.
