1. This is an application filed under Section 151 of CPC for withdrawal of the main case.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant/petitioner has submitted that the main case is now listed for 10.10.2023 and he wishes to withdraw the same and thus, prays for allowing of the application and for the preponement of the main case from 10.10.2023 to today itself.
3. On the other hand, learned State Counsel has submitted that she has no objection in case the present application is allowed and the date of hearing in the main case is preponed from 10.10.2023 to today itself for

final disposal.

4. For the reasons stated in the application and in view of no objection from the opposite side, the present application is allowed and the date of hearing in the main case is preponed from 10.10.2023 to today and the same is taken on Board today itself for final disposal.

Main case

1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to quash the departmental proceedings initiated against the petitioner dated 16.01.2023.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the fact that in the criminal case, the petitioner has been acquitted, he seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh petition after giving full and better particulars.

3. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present Civil Writ Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

4. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
