MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Criminal Procedure code for issuance of direction to officials respondents No. 2 and 3 to direct the respondents No. 4 to 6 not to harass and humiliate them.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that Ram Singh, who is son of petitioner No.1 is in bad company and stands disowned by him in the year 2019. He further submits that he is involved in three different FIRs and the particulars thereof are contained in para 4 of the petition. The petitioners are parents & other family members of Ram Singh (who is at large), but the police is harassing the petitioners by visiting their house without any notice. He submits that in this regard, he has given a representation dated 14.07.2023 (Annexure P-2) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala with a request that police officials be directed not to harass the petitioners.

Upon hearing learned counsel and considering his submissions, this Court finds that concededly Ram Singh son of petitioner No.1 is required by police and if the police officials are making an attempt to trace the fugitive

and visit the house of his parents, it cannot be construed as a harassment. Since this is the ordinary place of his residence, visit by the police is natural.

Thus, this Court is not inclined to exercise the power under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Dismissed.
