Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing impugned order dated 30.09.2021, Annexure P-3, and to direct the respondents to allow her to continue in service upto the age of sixty years as per Haryana Civil Services (General) Rule, 2016, Annexure P-4.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petition has become infructuous, as the petitioner has retired in February 2023, but salary for the last few months has not been paid.

Keeping in view of above, writ petition is rendered infructuous. However, in case salary for service rendered, has not been paid, the same be disbursed to the petitioner within a period of four weeks from the date of communication of copy of this order.
