Prayer has been made in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.41 dated 11.02.2022 registered under Sections 406/420/467/468/471 IPC at Police Station Bass, District Hansi, Haryana.

On 18.08.2022, following order was passed by this Court:-

“The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in the present case the allegations against the petitioner are that he had secured a loan against property of 36 kanals and the FIR was lodged on the ground that he was owner of property of 3 kanals but during the course of investigation it was found that he is owner of property of 22 kanals. He submitted that it is a case of default of bank loan and the property which has been mortgaged can also satisfy the entire loan since the entire loan is only Rs.5 lacs and the property is 22 kanals.

Meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation and on his doing so, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

As per the reply filed by way of affidavit dated 05.05.2023 of Shri Vinod Shankar, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Hansi on behalf of respondent No.1, petitioner has since joined the investigation.

Having regard to the reasons as mentioned in the order dated 18.08.2022 and that the petitioner has joined the investigation, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the order dated 18.08.2022 is hereby made absolute.
