Prayer in the present writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for decision of the Statutory Appeal dated 07.09.2021 (Annexure P-7) within a reasonable time.

2. The dispute apparently seems to be regarding the fact that balance 15% of the amount could not be deposited on account of some alleged mistake, wherein the wrong link had been pressed and the cancellation was done. Thus, the required 25% of the reserve price was not made good as per the terms of the auction. The matter is pending consideration before respondent No.1 regarding this aspect. It is also brought to our notice that money which was deposited is apparently still with the respondents.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Deepak Sabherwal, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-HSVP.

5. Resultantly, we deem it fit if the said statutory appeal is decided by the competent authority within a period of 2 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Needless to say that we have not observed on the merits of the case in any manner.

6. The writ petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
