Present writ petition has been filed for directing respondent No.3 to attest the mutation on the basis of the registered will of late Sh. Kapal Muni son of late Sh. Thakur Dass in respect of the properties situated in village Badheri, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner does not want the floor wise mutation to be sanctioned. He submits that the petitioner has filed his representation with a specific prayer that mutation of the property be entered as per the registered will dated 29.10.2014 and the settlement deed dated 25.02.2022, which are appended as Annexures P-1 and P-3 respectively with the petition. He submits that for the same, the petitioner has already filed his representation dated 07.03.2022 (Annexure P-4) to the Tehsildar

Revenue, UT, Chandigarh i.e. respondent No.3 along with the requisite documents.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents has submitted that the representation filed by the petitioner would be considered and decided in accordance with law.

In view of the above position, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 i.e. Executive Magistrate-cum-Tehsildar Revenue, UT, Chandigarh to decide the representation dated 07.03.2022 (Annexure P-4) filed by the petitioner in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from today.
