1. The criminal writ petition in the nature of Habeas Corpus is filed for releasing the detenue-petitioner as he has completed the awarded sentence of three years in FIR No. 32, dated 11th May, 2019, under Sections 458/ 323/ 324/ 326/ 354/ 148/ 149 of IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Bhaini Mian Khan, District Gurdaspur.

2. Reply filed by learned State counsel is taken on record.
Copy supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. As per the pleadings in the reply, petitioner was convicted in FIR No. 56, dated 14th August, 2018, under Sections 376, 506, 451 IPC and 67 of Information Technology Act, 2000 registered at PS Kahnuwan, District Gurdaspur on 9th December, 2019, resultantly, he has not undergone the sentence awarded in FIR No. 32.

4. In view of the reply filed by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner is not pressing the present petition, however seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.

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5. The petition is dismissed as not pressed with liberty as prayed for.
6. Since the main case has been dismissed as not pressed, pending application if any is rendered infructuous.
