The petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents to return back the tractor of the petitioner to him immediately as respondent No.4 is using his tractor illegally.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is the owner of a tractor make New Holland bearing registration No.PB-29R-4940. Respondent No.4, who is his son, has been residing separately from the petitioner but had been forcibly using his tractor. Various representations (Annexures P-2 to P-4) had been moved in the Police Department, however, in vain.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the relevant material available on record.

No ground is made out to issue directions as prayed for as it appears to be an *inter se* dispute between the petitioner and his son i.e. respondent No.4. Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
