1. This civil revision has been filed by the petitioner to set aside order dated 30.04.2019 (Annexure P-2) passed by learned Principal Judge, Family Court Barnala whereby warrant of recovery of arrears of maintenance to the tune of Rs.3,41,160/- as arrears of land revenue was issued.

2. While issuing notice of motion on 25.07.2019, it was directed that no coercive method be resorted to.

3. Learned counsel for the parties submit that the matter has been amicably resolved. Petition under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act has been filed and the same is now listed for recording of statements of parties of second motion.

4. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that adequate amount has been received by the respondents as per

settlement and there is no question of pursuing any recovery proceedings against the petitioner as of now.

5. Learned counsel for the parties submits that this revision petition thus be disposed of as infructuous in terms of the settlement arrived at between the parties.
