RAVI SHANKER JHA, C.J. (Oral)

In this matter, the Court had requested the learned counsel appearing for the parties to use their good offices to bring the litigation to an end. And, learned counsel for the parties have sought instructions from the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits and undertakes that the petitioner shall deposit a total sum of Rs.3.5 Lakh with the respondent-College by way of a demand draft or bankers' cheque. He further submits that an amount of Rs.1 Lakh has already been paid by the petitioner to the respondent-University at the time of admission, and the remaining amount, i.e. Rs.2.5 Lakh, shall be paid by her to the respondent-College by 15.02.2023.

In response, learned counsel for the respondent-College submits that immediately on receiving the aforesaid amount, the respondent-College would issue No Objection Certificate giving quietus to the matter, in terms of the compromise arrived at between the parties.

It is clarified that in case the petitioner hands over a total sum of Rs.2.5 Lakh to the respondent-College by way of a demand draft or bankers' cheque on or before 15.02.2023, she would be permitted to continue and pursue her studies.

On the basis of the aforesaid statements made by learned counsel for the parties, and the undertaking given by them before this Court, the petition stands disposed of in terms thereof.
