Present writ petition has been filed for directing respondent No.3 to take and issue appropriate necessary action/instructions to comply with the orders of respondents No.2 while directing respondent No.3 to issue NOC for obtaining and applying the electric connection relating to the smooth functioning of the business the mainstay of his livelihood as respondent No.3 is sitting tight over the matter inspite of the fact that the resolutions have been passed in favour of the petitioner to allot the land vide resolution NO,79/347 dated 31.12.2012 (Annexure P-4) and resolution No.27/27 dated 31.05.2013 (Annexure P-5) with the revised rent rate @ Rs.1250/- rent/tehbazari per month for the alternative site allotted to the petitioner as approved by the respondents in favour of the petitioner. Further prayer has been made for directing respondent No.3 nor to create hindrance & to implement the resolutions (Annexures P-4 & P-5).

Perusal of the record shows that from the last about three dates, the petitioner is not represented by anyone. On the last date i.e. on 31.08.2023, when the case came up for hearing, none had appeared for the petitioner, so in the interest of justice, it was adjourned for today. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner today as well.

It appears that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the present petition.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed for non prosecution.
