1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of FIR No.46 dated 04.03.2022, registered for offences under Sections 323, 324, 341, 379-B and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Rama Mandi, District Jalandhar, Annexure P-1, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of the compromise dated 14.07.2023, Annexure P-2, arrived at between the parties.

2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been released on default bail and the petition, preferred by him, (CRM-M-953-2023) seeking grant of regular bail, which is pending before this Court, has

become infructuous. Counsel submits that victim-respondent No.3 is not a signatory to the compromise, Annexure P-2.

3. Upon instructions received from ASI, Tehal Dass, State counsel submits that the petitioner has a criminal past and is named in three other criminal cases.

4. At this stage, counsel for the petitioner seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the petition with liberty to file a fresh one in case a fresh compromise is arrived at between the parties.

5. Dismissed as withdrawn.
