HARSH BUNGER J. (ORAL)

1. The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for setting aside impugned award dated 13.06.2016 (Annexure P-6) passed by respondent No.1, whereby respondent No.2 has been awarded compensation of Rs.2.50 Lacs against the petitioners and respondent No.3 jointly and severally and further liberty has been granted to respondent No.3 to recover the same from the petitioners. A further prayer has been made to stay the operation of impugned award dated 13.06.2016 (Annexure P-6) during pendency of the instant writ petition.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in view of the

order of even date passed in *CWP-5136-2017* titled as “*Sunil Kumar Jha vs. Presiding Officer, Central Govt. Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court-II, Chandigarh and others*”, the petitioners do not intend to press the instant writ petition any further.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present writ petition is dismissed as not pressed.
