Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to respondent No.1 to order for demarcation of the land measuring 375 sq. Yds. bearing Khasra No.174 min, Khata/Khatoni No.388/517, jamabandi for the year 2006-2007 which has been purchased by the petitioner and the revenue officials despite repeated representations have not conducted the demarcation and further to consider the representation dated 25.06.2021 (Annexure P-3) in a time bound manner and to direct respondents No.2 to 4 to conduct the demarcation of the land of the petitioner.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has already deposited demarcation fee about two years ago, but till date nothing has been done. He submits that the petitioner has also filed representation dated 25.06.2021 (Annexure P-3) before the Deputy Commissioner, Amritsar.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and perusing the record, it is apparent that the only grievance of the petitioner is regarding demarcation of his land but surprisingly the same has not been done even after two years of his filing representation (Annexure P-3). The present petition is disposed of with a direction to Deputy Commissioner-cum-District Collector, Amritsar to ensure that the demarcation proceedings with regard to the land of the petitioner are completed within a period of 15 days from today.
