Learned State counsel has submitted the Status-Report on behalf of the respondent-State (by way of the affidavit of the Assistant Commissioner of Police, Civil Lines, Ludhiana), along-with the copy of the order dated 29.07.2023 passed by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ludhiana, whereby the petitioner has been declared proclaimed person, in the Court today and these documents are taken on the record.
