This is a civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* for quashing of the impugned interim order dated 17.05.2017 (Annexure P-8) vide which an interim order has been passed in the revision petition filed by respondents No.5 to 7.

Learned counsel appearing for the State as well as for the private respondents have submitted that the said writ petition has been rendered infructuous as the same was against the interim order and the Financial Commissioner has passed a final order, which has been challenged in CWP No.5847 of 2018.

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Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in view of the same, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may kindly be disposed of as such with liberty to the petitioners to pursue CWP No.5847 of 2018.

In view of the above said fact, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. Liberty is granted to the petitioners to pursue CWP No.5847 of 2018.
