1. The present is a second petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of the order dated 09.08.2022 (Annexure P-4) whereby the bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 06.06.2020 was cancelled and non-bailable warrants were issued vide order dated 07.10.2022 (Annexure P-8) whereby the proclamation proceedings against the petitioner were instituted and vide order dated 03.07.2023 (Annexure P-9) the petitioner was declared as P.O.

2. On the last date of hearing, on the basis of the statement of the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner was directed to surrender before the learned trial Court within a period of three weeks.

3. Today, the learned State counsel has stated on instructions from ASI Sukhdev Singh that the petitioner has already surrendered before the learned trial Court in pursuance of the order dated 24.07.2023

4. In view of the aforesaid position, the present petition is

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disposed of as having become redundant since the petitioner has already surrendered as per the learned State counsel.

5. Since the learned counsel for the petitioner is not present today, liberty is granted to the petitioner that in case any cause of action survives, then an appropriate application can be filed in the present case.
