The petitioner has filed the present petition praying for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.273 dated 22.06.2019 under Sections 302, 323, 34 IPC and 25 Arms Act, 1959 (Sections 216, 307, 120-B IPC were added lateron and Section 25 of Arms Act was deleted), registered at Police Station Gannuar, District Sonipat.

Custody certificate by learned State counsel is filed in Court today. The same is taken on record.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the case is going at slow pace before the trial Court. The petitioner is in custody since 25.11.2019. He prays that the trial Court may be requested to dispose of the matter expeditiously.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to expedite the trial as expeditiously as possible, preferably, within a period of *six months* keeping in view the custody of the petitioner.
