ANOOP CHITKARA, J.

Seeking regular bail in case FIR No.57 dated 16.04.2019 registered under Sections 302, 307, 506, 148, 149, 120-B IPC and Sections 25, 27, 29, 54 & 59 of Arms Act at Police Station Chheharata, District Amritsar, the petitioner has come up before this Court under Section 439 CrPC.

2. Notice served upon the official respondent(s) through the state counsel.

3. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had suffered injuries and he has to undergo continuous treatment. He further submits that earlier the petitioner was also granted interim bail on medical grounds and prayed for grant of bail.

4. Counsel for the State has opposed the present petition on the ground that in a petition filed by the co-accused, this Court had already issued direction to conclude the trial in a time bound manner.

5. At this stage, counsel for the petitioner prayed for withdrawal of the petition and seeks direction to jail authorities to provide proper treatment to the petitioner.
6. Given the submission of counsel for the petitioner, concerned Superintendent of Jail is directed to ensure proper and adequate treatment be given to the petitioner. State to convey this order to the concerned Jail Superintendent.
7. Petition is disposed of as withdrawn with the above said observation. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
