Present petition under Section 482 Cr. P.C. has been filed seeking directions to respondents to hand over the complaint dated 18.07.2022 (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioner to some higher officials or to some independent agency for conducting the proper enquiry and taking the further appropriate action in accordance with law against respondent Nos.5 to 9-Police officials, for giving the grievous injuries on the person of husband of the petitioner.

Brief facts of the case are that on 25.06.2022, one Balwinder @ Kala was creating nuisance near MATA temple in Kaithal and the petitioner tried to tell said Balwinder @ Kala not to do the same at a public place. Meanwhile, police reached the spot and arrested said Balwinder @ Kala along with husband of the petitioner and case FIR No.314, dated 25.06.2022, under Sections 394, 332, 353, 34 IPC, PS City Kaithal, District Kaithal, was registered against them.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not committed any offence and has falsely been roped in. He is being

tortured by respondent Nos.5 to 9. In this regard, the petitioner had submitted a complaint dated 18.07.2022 (Annexure P-4) to The Superintendent of Police, Kaithal-respondent No.3, but the same has not been decided till date. He further submits that the petitioner would be content if her complaint is decided within a time bound manner.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, instant petition is ***disposed of*** with the direction to Superintendent of Police, Kaithal to look into the matter, to dispose of the complaint and to take appropriate legal steps if any, as per law expeditiously within ***three months*** on receipt of certified copy of this order.
