Power of Attorney has been filed on behalf of the complainant- Ranjit Singh as well as victim- Rajandeep Kaur.

Learned counsel appearing for the complainant and victim informs that matter has since been compromised between the parties.

Custody certificate of petitioner -Jashanpreet Singh has been placed on record; whereas custody certificate of petitioner – Madhuvir Malik as filed earlier is relied.

By way of present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., petitioners have prayed for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.55 dated 10.06.2023 registered under Section 379B, 341, 34 IPC (offence under Section 411 IPC added later on) at Police Station Maloud, District Khanna.

As per allegations, on 31.05.2023, at about 06:00 PM, snatching was committed from Rajandeep Kaur by three persons. On the statement of father of

said Rajandeep Kaur, FIR was lodged. As per prosecution, later on the victim had identified the petitioners to be the snatchers.

As per the custody certificates, both the petitioners are in custody since 13.06.2023 which means that their custody period is 05 months and 29 days i.e. almost six months. None of them have any criminal antecedents.

As per statement made by counsel for the complainant and the victim, matter has already been compromised between the parties.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. Petitioners are admitted to bail on their furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/ Duty Magistrate concerned.
